The NEW design slim tube bubbles look cool but they blow very small bubbles that sink. The older style in the first picture has a larger bubble wand that makes larger bubbles that float in the air longer. If you plan to use these outdoors instead of rice or bird seed as you leave the church remember that bubbles don't work well in the wind. If you want them at an indoor reception you must be very careful and ask the venue if they allow these. On some dance floors these bubbles can make the floor slippery. Some venues just don't want the mess.
